The PDC Under-21 World Championships has been confirmed that will see 64 qualifiers competing at the Barnsley Metrodrome in England on Saturday November 6, 2010. An invite will be extended to one Canadian as an international qualifier.

The 64 qualifiers will play down to the two finalists who will compete for the Under-21 World Championship title at the Ladbrokes.com World Darts Championship at Alexandra Palace in London England in December.

Player's eligibility into other World events may be affected by participating in this competition.

Prize package for this event is as follows. (Currency conversion today is £1 = \$1.64).

Winner £ 10,000.

Runner-Up £ 5,000.

Semi-finalists £ 2,500 each.

.Quarter finalists £ 1,250 each.

Last 16 losers £625 each.

Due to time constraints the WDF/NDFC ranked Klondike tournament will be utilized for this qualifier.

The NDFC will be running a PDC Under-21 World Qualifier at the 2010 Klondike Open to advance a Canadian player to compete. (The qualifier is not part of the Klondike event). Format will be straight knockout best of 11 legs. NDFC seeding will be utilized. Tournament Director....Bill Hatter.... Registration deadline is Saturday October 9, 2010 at 2pm. NO EXCEPTIONS. Qualifier to take place Saturday evening time TBA.

Players must compete in the qualifier to be eligible to qualify for the PDC Under 21 World Championships.

Proof of age will be required at the qualifier. Open to players aged between 16 and 21 who must have been born between 4 January 1989 and 3 January 1995.

Entry fee will be \$40 per player with entry fee proceeds (up to a maximum of \$1,000) to the winner. There is no cash payout for this qualifier. Winner's name will be forwarded to the PDC liaison for entry submission into the draw.
